

# HOSTELRY HARD CELL

ONCE home to murderers, thieves and hardened criminals, some former prisons in Europe have now been revamped into plush hostel accommodation.

Such an example is the The Langholmens Vandrarhem Hostel in Stockholm, Sweden – once home to some of the worst convicts in Europe – where you can stay in a freshly-renovated prison cell from just €24pp.

Or how about visiting Slovenia, where you can get locked up for the night at the hip Hostel Celica, where the ex-prison's iron bars are artfully placed on doors and windows?

The hostel is right in the centre of Ljubljana, itself enjoying something of a cultural revolution, and you can stay the night from €19pp.

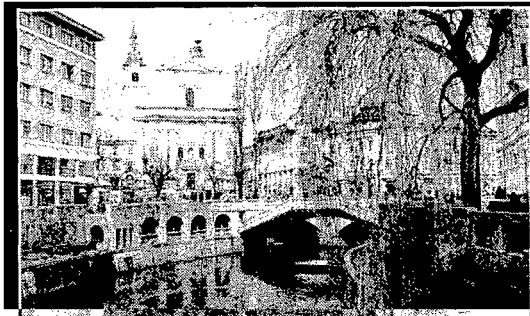
Thrill-seekers can check out St Christopher's Hostel in Edinburgh, Scotland.
